

BMAT Primary Schools Risk Assessment – Key Points

Overarching risk – the contraction and transmission of SARS-COV-2 COVID (Coronavirus)

Risk	Mitigation	Risk Level
1. Asymptomatic Transition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Twice weekly testing for all staff, and secondary students. • Essential visitors to schools only. • Adults to wear masks when moving around the schools in confined spaces (primary) 	Medium
2. Stress and Anxiety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EAP Programme available to all BMAT staff. • This risk assessment and accompanying full guidance will be available on the Intranet and school website. • Individual staff risk assessments have been completed where applicable. • Coronavirus policies and safety procedures are available to all staff which set out how staff should behave and the precautions they must adopt during the pandemic to keep them safe. • CEV staff are currently shielding 	Low
3. Spread/contraction of COVID-19 due to lack of social distancing measures during the school day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protocols in place for the start and end of the school day. • Teachers will have their own classrooms and desk screens • Pupils being kept in bubbles in accordance with the government guidance. • Social distancing measures including distance markings, screens, signage in place to remind all occupants of the buildings. • Where possible, all spaces are well-ventilated using natural ventilation (opening windows) or ventilation units. • Occupation of offices reduced to meet 2m social distancing guidelines. • Reduced use of staff rooms/PPA space, with specific capacity. • Appropriate PPE will be provided to all those who require it. • One to one SEN staff working closely with SEN pupils are to wear a visor, or transparent face covering (provided by the school) 	Medium
4. Spread/contraction of COVID-19 due to lack of hand-washing and general poor hygiene.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clear hand washing protocols in place • Hand gel sanitiser and anti-bacterial wipes are in place for all to use. 	Medium
5. Spread/contraction of COVID-19 due to inadequate cleaning measures.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regular cleaning schedule in place across the schools, including day cleaners. • Pupils asked to keep the belongings to a minimum. • Equipment of all kinds to be cleaned between use. 	Low
6. Spread/contraction of COVID-19 due to insufficient First aid measures.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clear First Aid protocols and risk assessment in place. 	Low
7. Spread/contraction of Covid-19 due not acting appropriately when a case is suspected or confirmed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clear protocols to manage suspected protocols in place. 	Low
